

HOW TO APPLY

Surface Preparation:



Ensure the surface is clean, dry and free from oil and wax before application. Smoothen the surface using Emery paper 180 followed by Emery paper 320. If necessary, fill the wood grains with appropriate filler and then smoothen with Emery paper 320. For re-painting, remove all unstable paint film, dust, oil, wax and other foreign particles before application.

Top Coat Nippon Paint Melamic



Apply 2-3 coat

Allow it to dry

for 16 hours



Apply 2-3 coat





Allow it to dry for 6-8 hours

Application:

Brush : Dilute all glossy, matt and sealer with 10 - 15%

by volume using Nippon Paint Melamic Thinner

Roller : N.A.

Conventional spray : Dilute all glossy, matt and sealer with 20 - 25%

by volume using Nippon paint Melamic Thinner

SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENT

Always work in a well ventilated area. Wear appropriate attire, especially gloves and eye protection gear. Avoid contact with skin as it may cause irritation.

Cleaning all tools with GP Thinner or Melamic Thinner.

Safety Instructions:

In the case of eye contact, rinse immediately with water and seek immediate medical treatment. To remove paint from skin, use soap and water or appropriate cleanser. In the event of spillage, contain and collect spilt paint by using sand or earth.

Precautions:

Avoid painting when the temperature is below 10°C. Painting is not recommended If the moisture content is high. Moisture content of the wood should be below 16%.

Store paint in a cool, dry and well ventilated place away from heat sources, flammables or direct sunlight. Keep container tightly closed in a secure, upright position. Do not store near food, drink or animal feed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not dispose of unwanted paint into drains, water sources or open sewers. To dispose safely, pour unwanted paint onto old newspapers and let dry before placing in a proper waste receptacle

Disposal Information:

Disposal of any paint waste & containers in accordance with applicable Environment (Protection) Act 1986 under the Hazardous Wastes (Management & Handling) rules 1989.
